For that reason, we are opening a **Black and Blue Clinic** so players can be evaluated in an office setting during the week.

This clinic will be on Monday and Tuesday afternoons at our office in Kensington. There, we will have the resources (X-ray, casting materials, braces, etc.) to more completely evaluate and treat these injuries. Our office staff will make every effort to work players in on an "add-on" basis. My time with the team and on the sideline is purely voluntary. However, when players come to the office in Kensington, we will have to bill for these services. Our office participates with most area insurance plans.
