  - c) ACT score of 24 or an SAT score of 1100 (Verbal and Math only)
2. Applicant must have participated in two (2) sports for at least two (2) years in each sport
3. Applicant must have earned at least one (1) varsity letter in each of two (2) sports
4. Applicant must complete attached scholar/essay application
5. Applicant must have a letter of recommendation from the high school athletic administrator/director
6. School athletic director must be an NIAAA member and a member of their respective state athletic administrators association (**MSADA**)
7. The principal or athletic director must sign the application to ensure that the academic information submitted is accurate.
